In the 1800s, it was popular to have your portrait taken. The metal brace kept the head still.

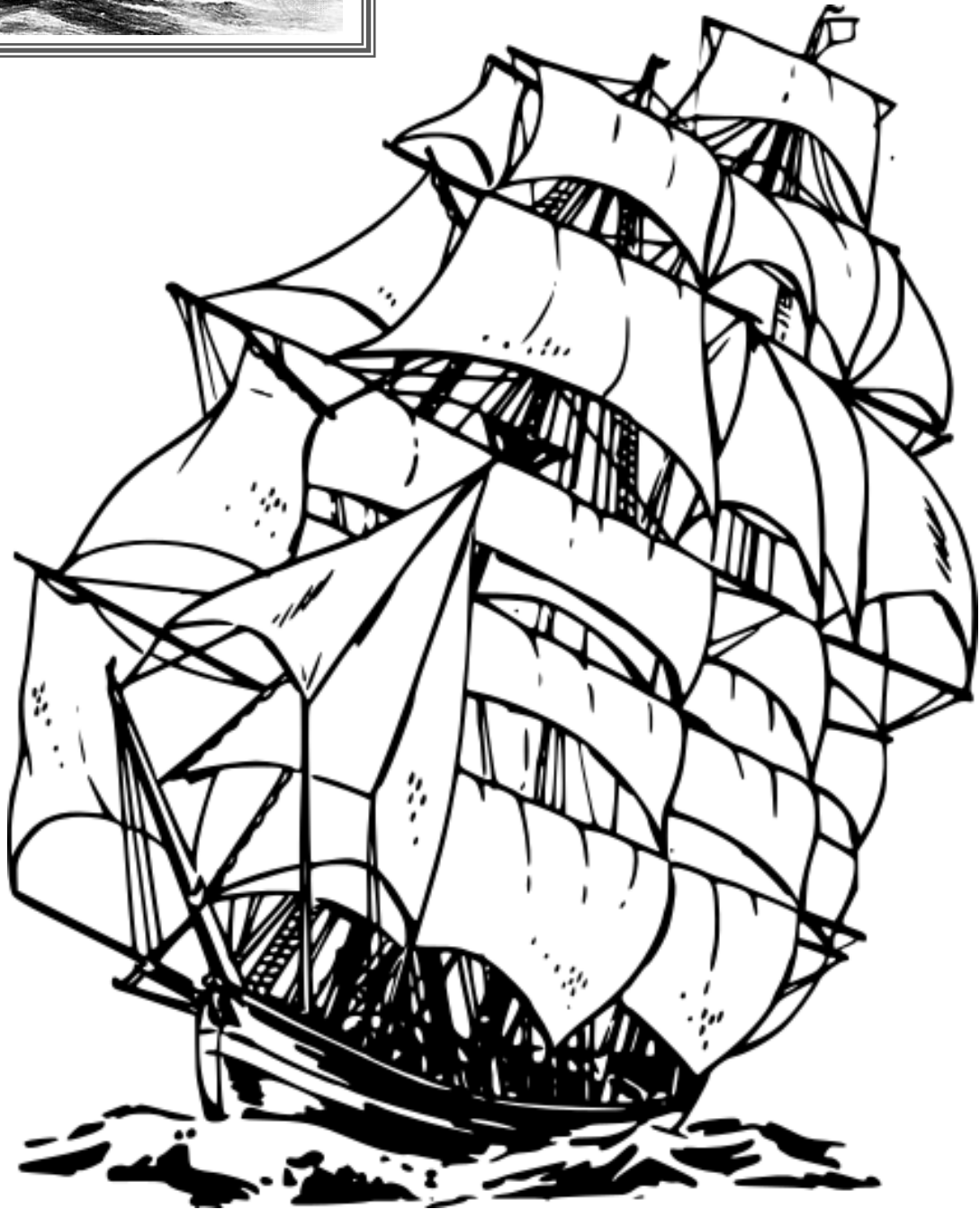

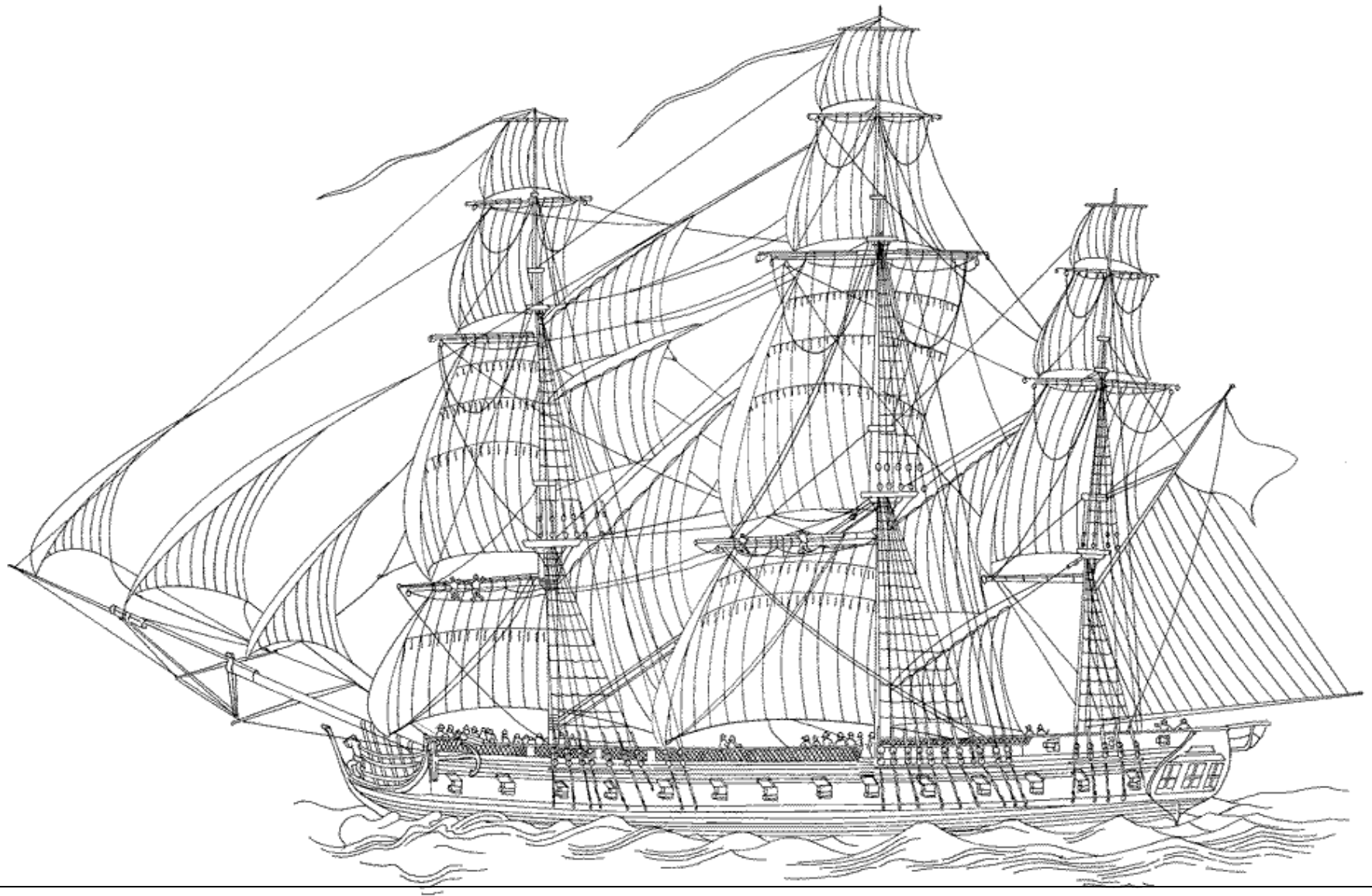

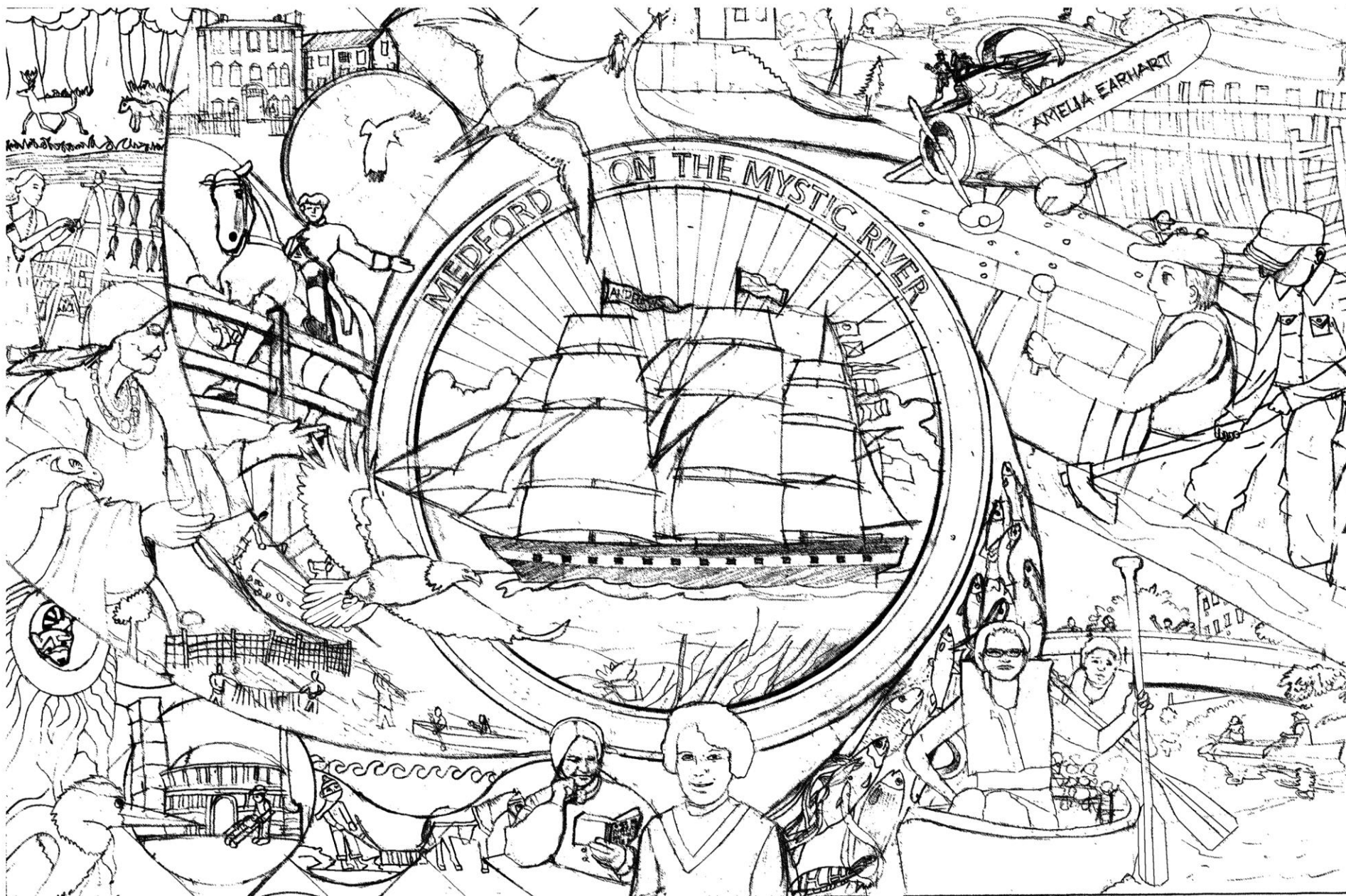
